

Niceville Valparaiso Rotary Club Scholarship

Application Deadline: On or Before Friday, April 19, 2019



The Rotary Club of Niceville/Valparaiso is a club created to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster, high ethical standards; the application of service in one's personal, business, and community life; and the advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through individuals united in the idea of service.

The number of scholarships and scholarship amounts depends upon funds available at the time the Rotary Scholarship Committee awards the scholarships, but are typically given in \$1000 increments

Rotarians live by the 4-Way Test. They ask:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?**
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?**
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?**

Academic Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

1. The scholarship is to be used at a post-high school institution beginning in the fall after graduation from high school.
2. Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - Community service and leadership exhibited within the school environment
 - Community service and leadership exhibited outside of the school environment
 - Academic performance
 - Student essay
 - One letter of recommendation.

Instructions for Completing and Submitting the Application:

1. Fully complete and submit the attached application and required essay.
2. Submit one (1) letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or administrator
3. Submit an unofficial high school transcript. **A school official must sign academic section as verification of the accuracy of the information provided.**

Deadline for Submission: Applications **MUST BE POSTMARKED** by Friday, April 19, 2019.
